The Certified Defense Financial Manager™ (CDFM) is an investment in your career—but not an investment you have to make alone! Most departments and employers offer financial assistance for pursuing or maintaining CDFM certification.

The Credentialing Opportunities On-Line (COOL) program helps service members and government civilians find information on civilian certifications and licenses related to their profession. COOL programs may pay for training, materials, and/or exams that lead to industry-recognized civilian credentials. NOTE: Must pass Modules 1, 2, and 3 to earn the CDFM. Must also pass Module 4 to earn the CDFM-A. A retake requires an additional exam purchase.
